

Personal Itinerary Builder

How to add presentations to your itinerary and how to export your itinerary

You may use the Personal Itinerary Builder after you have registered with your email address and a password of choice. A confirmation email of your login details will be sent to your email address.

Once logged in you will see your empty personal itinerary. Click on the red **X** or besides the pop-up to close this window and to start to browse the scientific program. You will stay logged into personal itinerary builder as long as your browser window (tab) remains open and you don't press F5 to reload the page.



Click on the search button to browse and search the scientific programme based on various search criteria. Open a session and presentation to see these icons that help you to add or remove presentations or sessions from your personal itinerary:

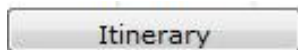


Click on this icon to add an item to your personal itinerary.
